This situation led to the Executive, to order from the 06AGO16, Operation "Controlled Flow", to provide humanitarian assistance to INMIR, establishing the necessary health and safety controls, guaranteeing the well-being of national citizens and INMIR.

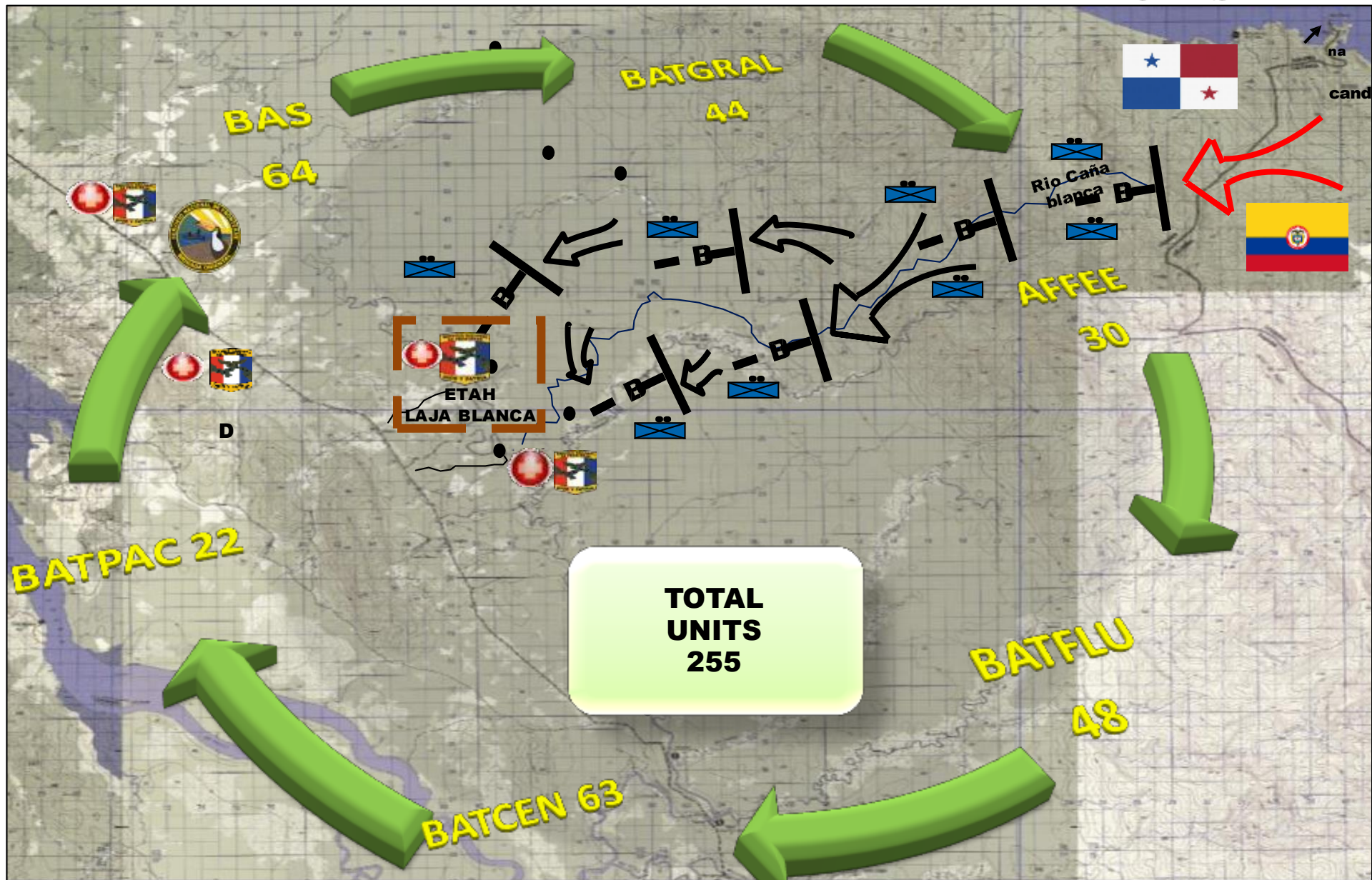

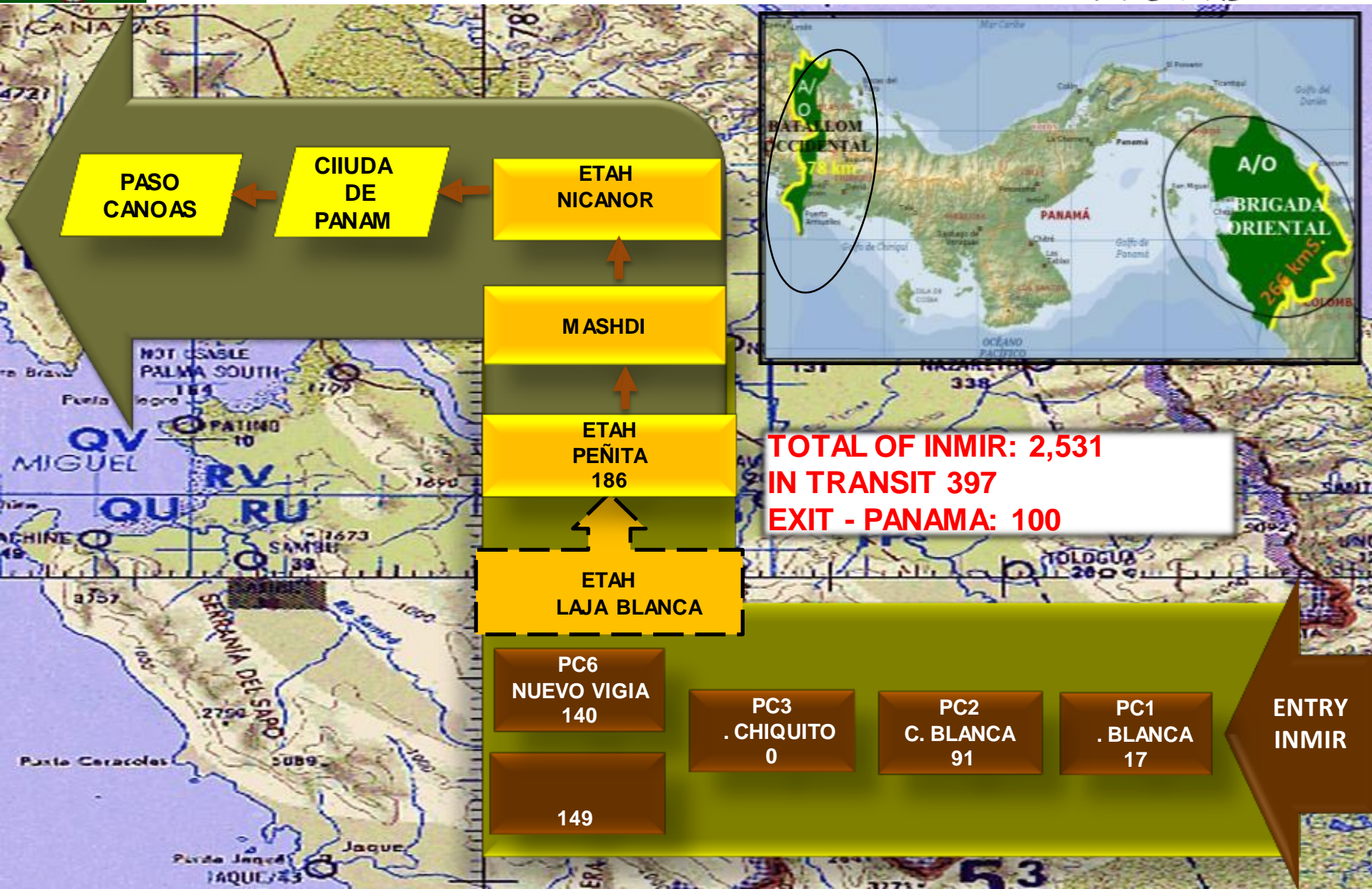




ENTRY AND EXIT FLOW

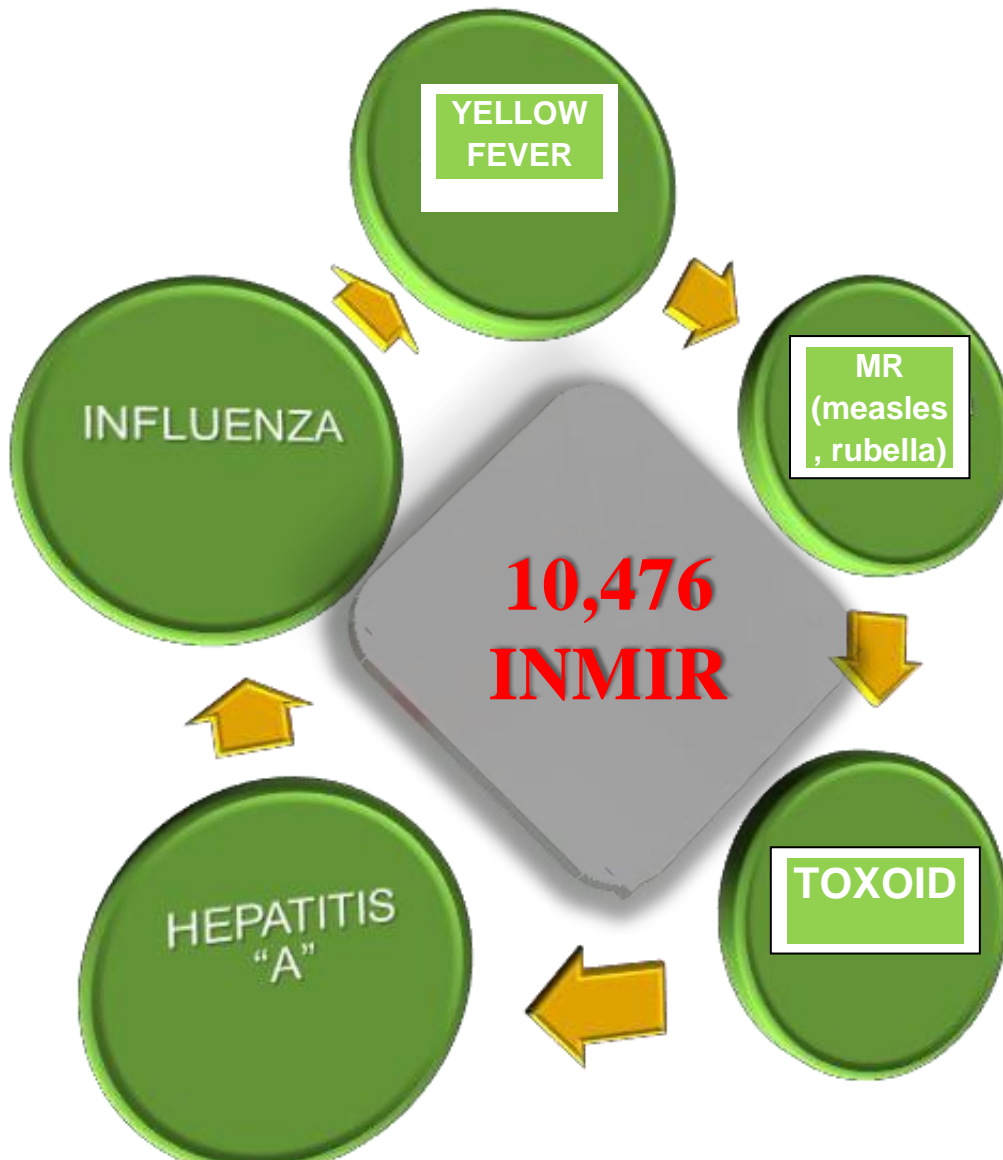

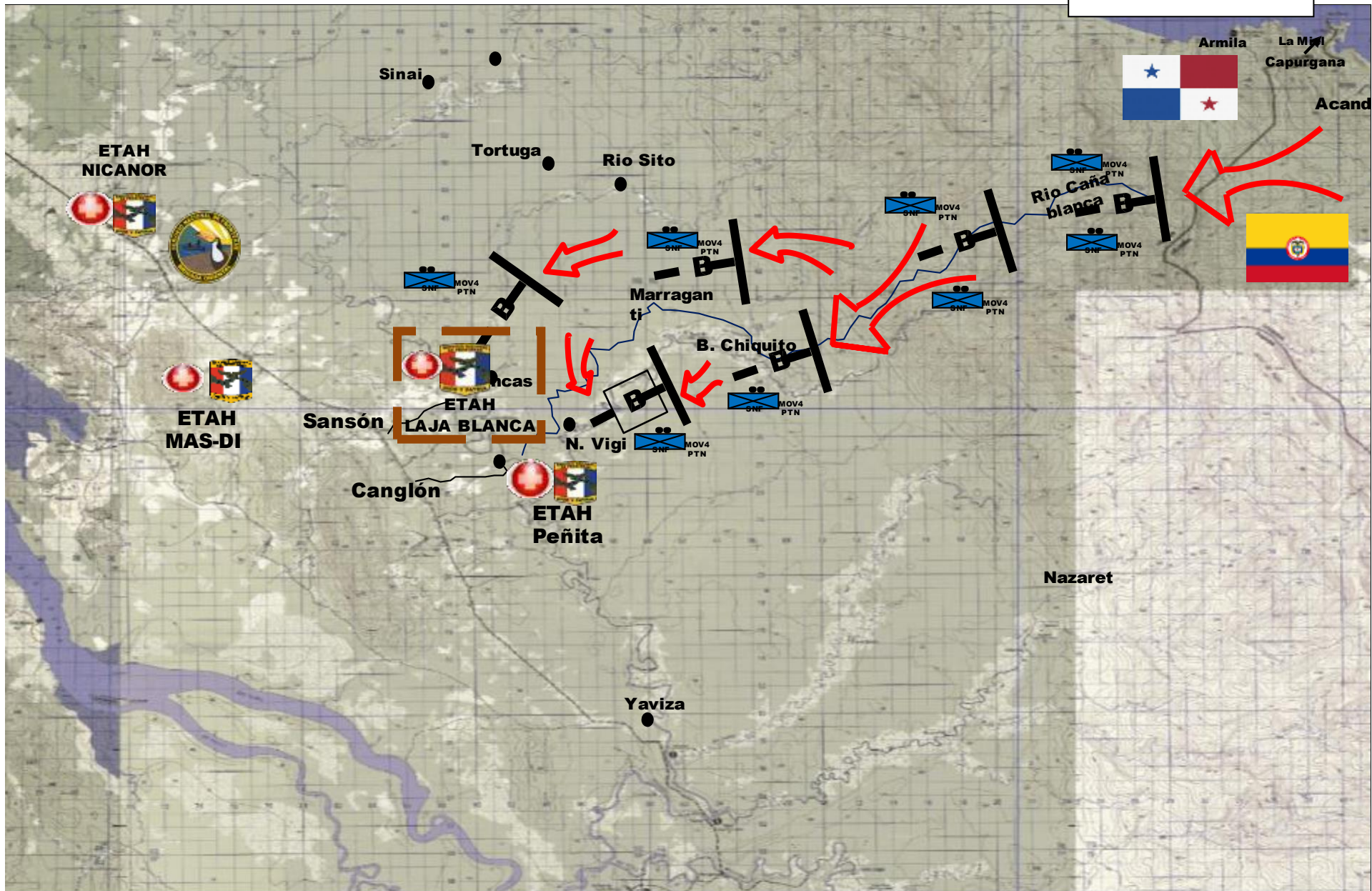

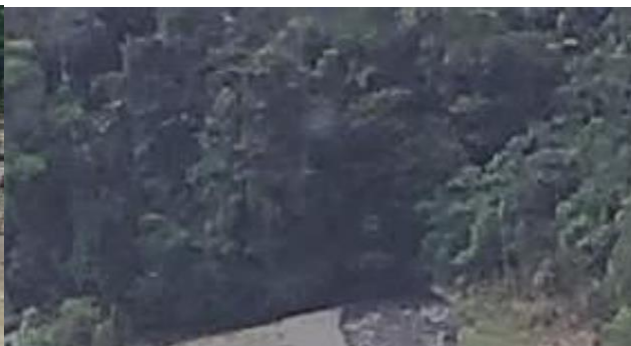

- Minimum séjour pour 5 jours.
Etre patienté.
- Respecté l'autorité et ses règles ici.
- Nous donnons des sécurité, repas, habitation et médecine.
- Pour pouvoir continuer, tout le monde doit voir un docteur.
- Alcoolique boissons ne sont pas permis.
- Arrête du sortir sans indication et causer des problèmes.
- Si vous avez mal physiquement, dire un officiel.
- Maintenez la région propre, nettoyer, sans ordures.
- La priorité sont les femmes enceinte, les enfants, et personnes d'un certain âge.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MIGRANTS (ENGLISH)

- The minimum stay here is 5 days, please be patient.
- Respect authority and follow the rules.
- We guarantee security, food, housing and health.
- In order to continue, everyone should be vaccinated and see a doctor.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Do not try to leave and don't cause conflict.
- If you feel sick, tell an officer.
- Help keep the area clean and free of trash.
- Prioritize pregnant women, children and the oldmen.

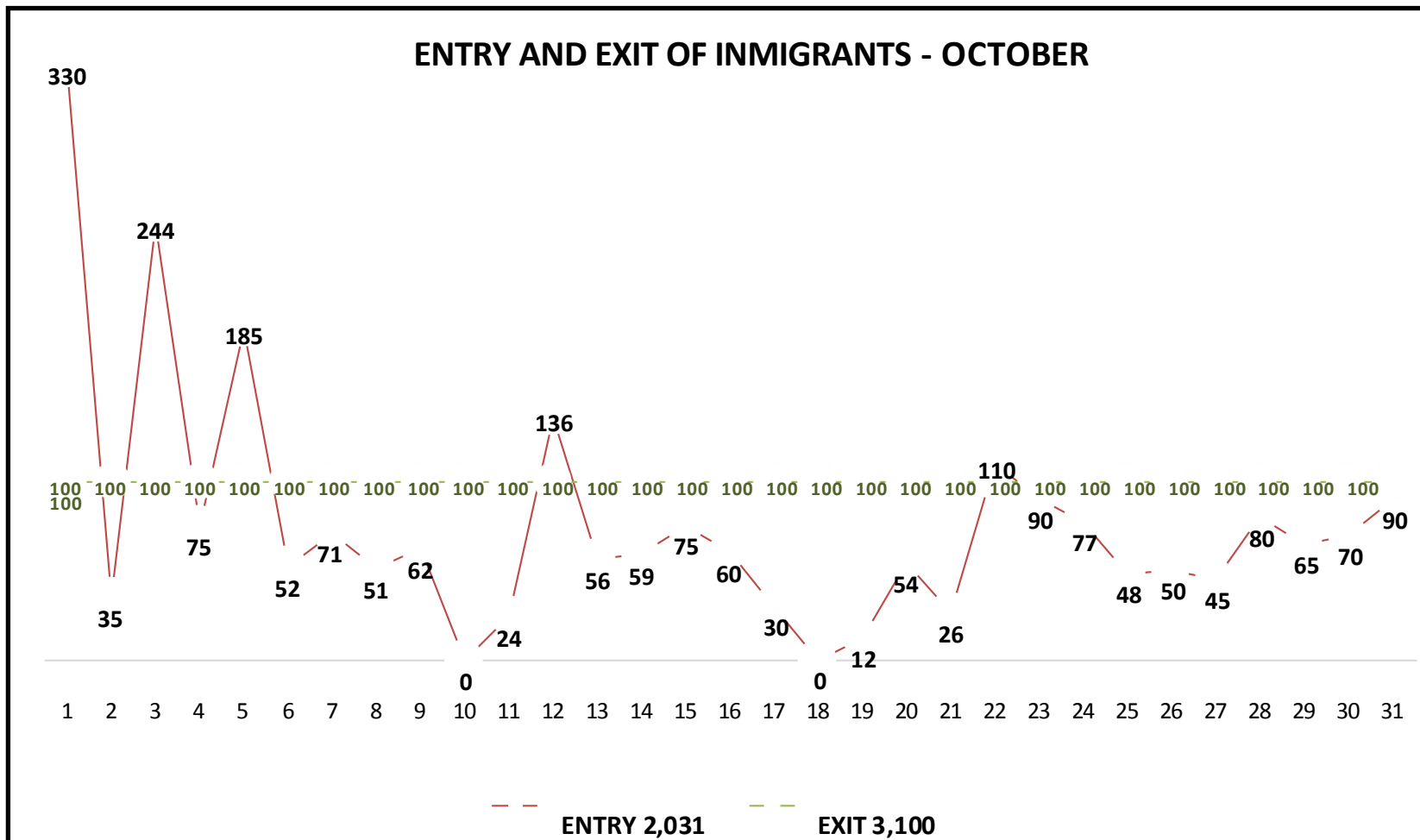

COMPARATIVE TABLE OF ENTRY VS EXIT OF INMIGRANTS OCTUBRE 2016

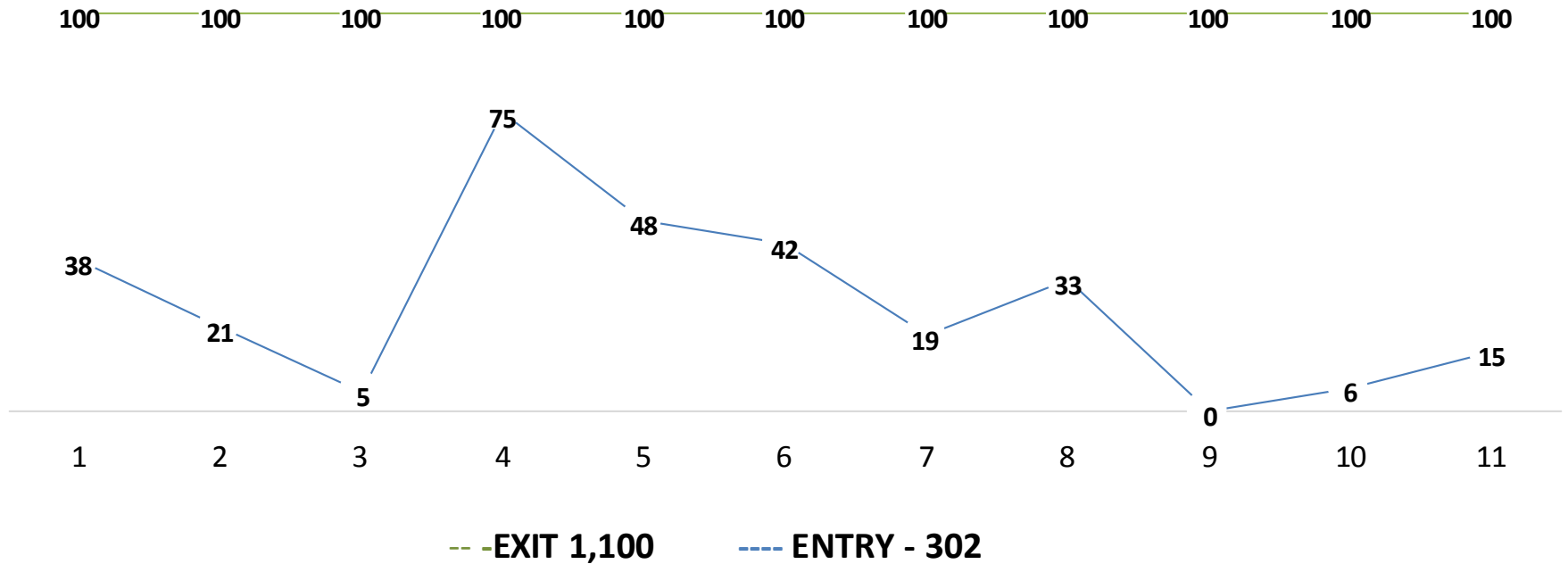

COMPARATIVE TABLE OF ENTRY VS EXIT OF INMIGRANTS TO PANAMA NOVEMBER 2016

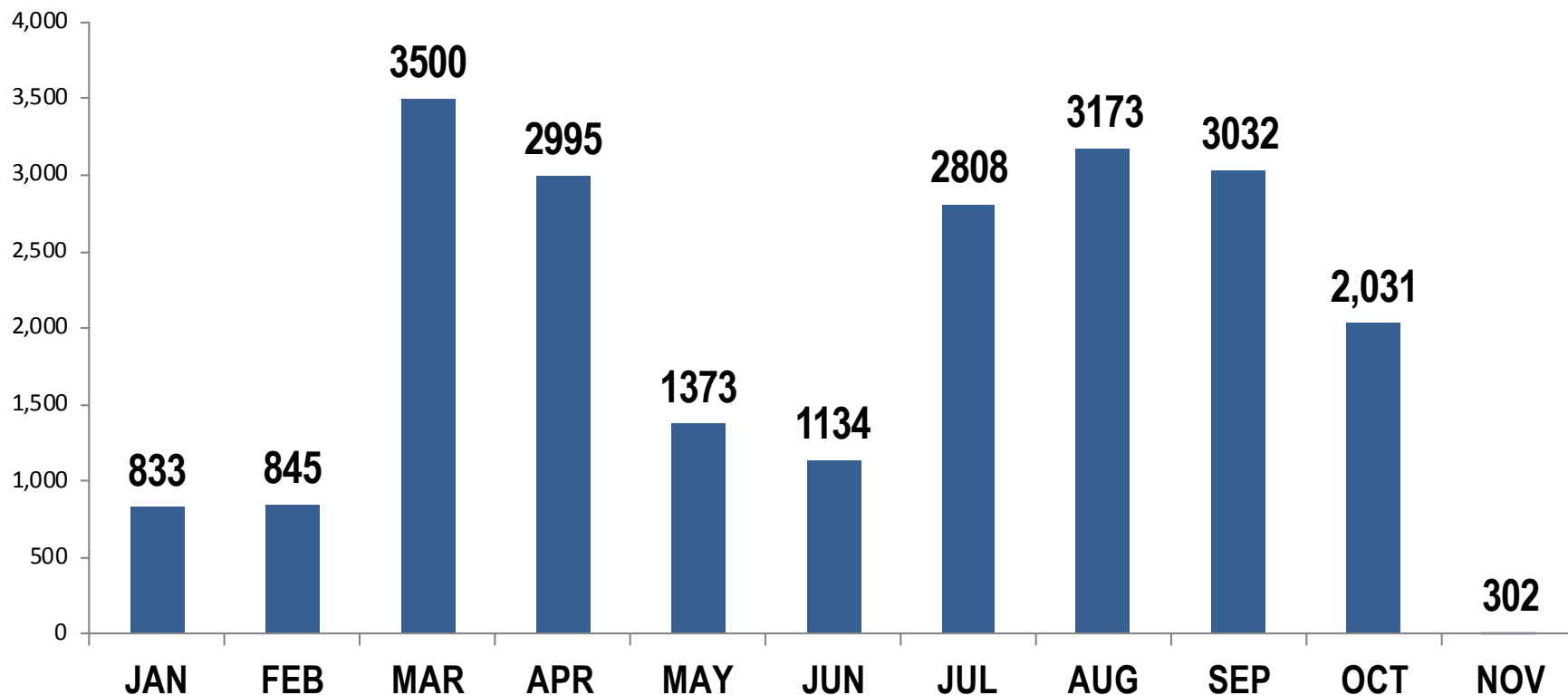

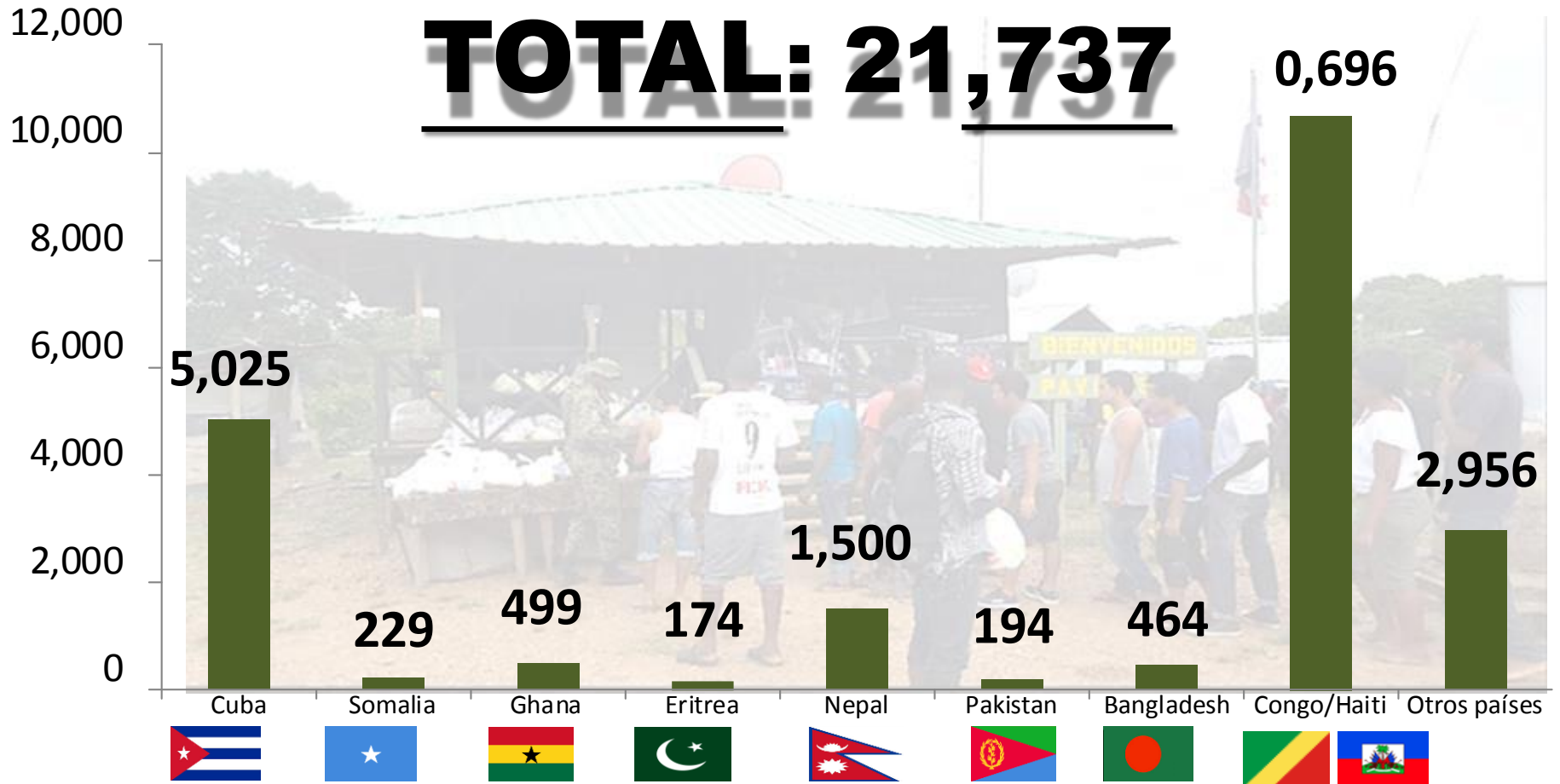
MONTHLY GRAPHIC OF IRREGULAR IMMIGRANTS JANUARY – NOVEMBER 2016

GRAPHIC OF IRREGULAR INMIGRANTS PER NATIONALITY JANUARY-NOVEMBER 2016

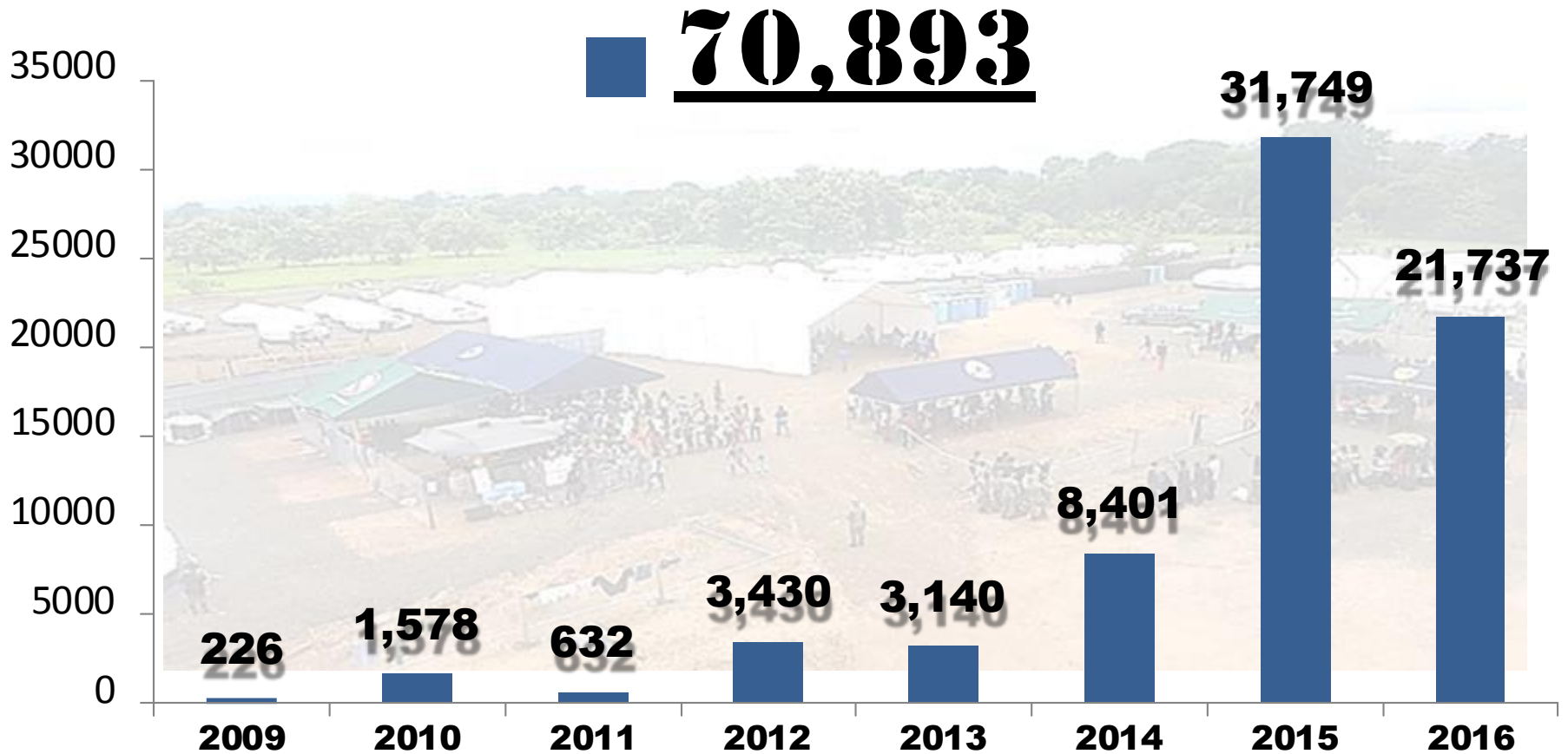

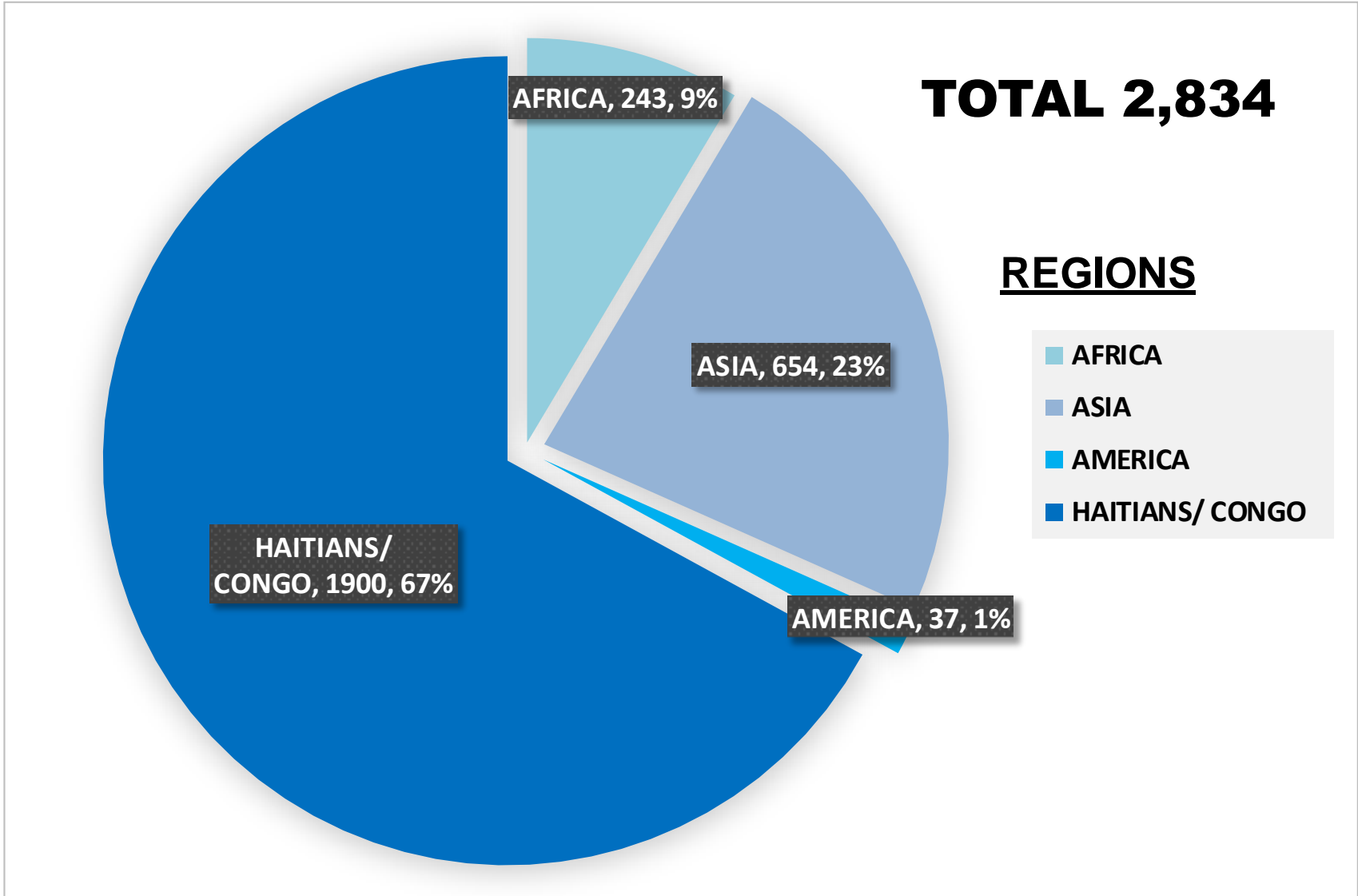

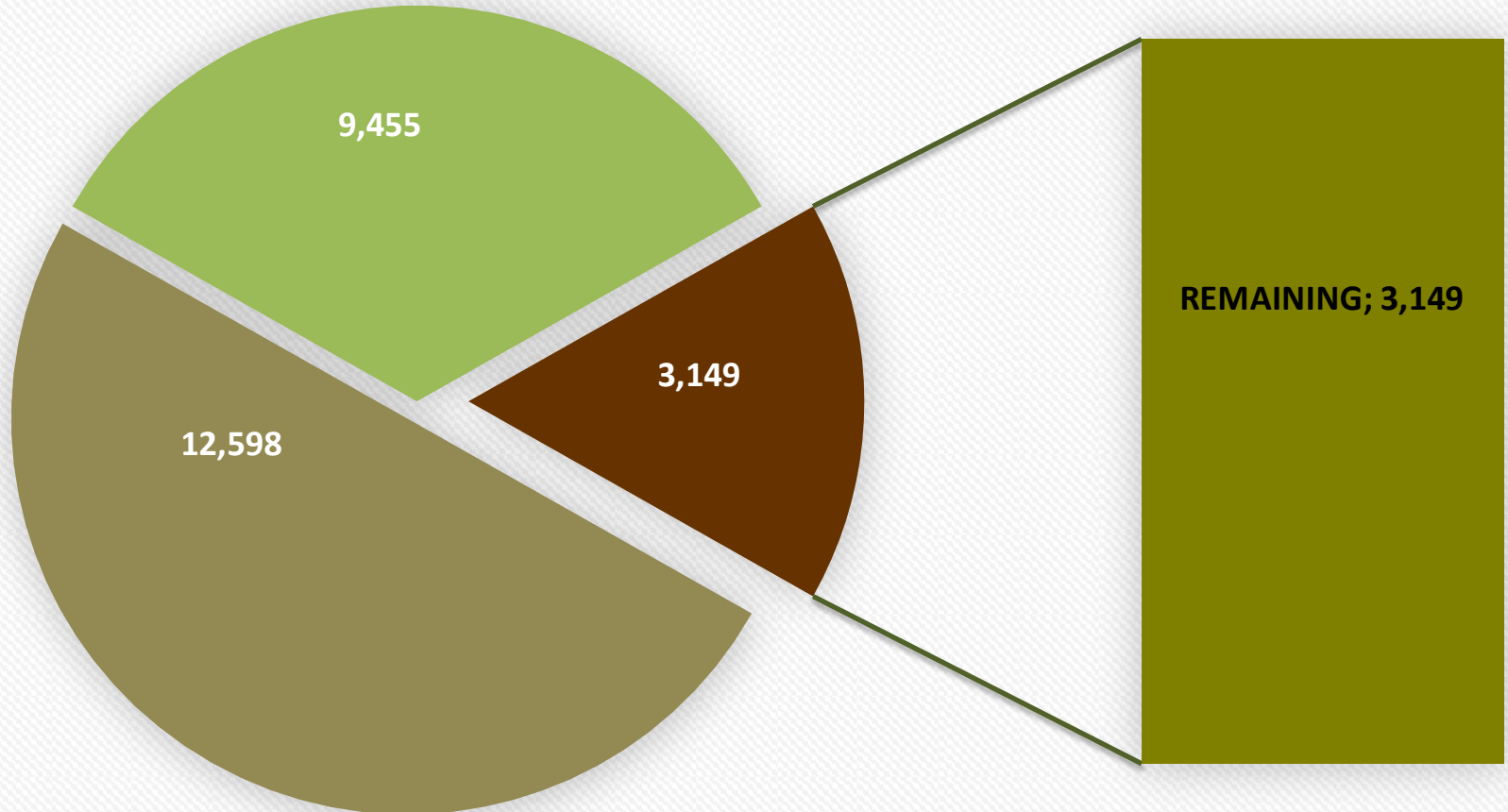
**COMPARATIVE GRAPHIC OF THE ACTUAL
