# Priorities for cooperation: Addis Ababa Action Plan



- Increase cooperation in relation to access to earned benefits and their transferability, enhance the recognition of qualifications, education and skills obtained abroad, reduce hiring costs for migrants and combat unscrupulous employers.
- ❖ Implement effective social communication strategies on the contribution of migrants to sustainable development in all its dimensions, particularly in the countries of destination, in order to combat xenophobia, facilitate social integration and protect the human rights of migrants.
